Our Message

The Bible, God's Word, says you can know for sure that you have eternal life in heaven after death. “These things have I written unto you . . . that ye may know that ye have eternal life.” (1 John 5:15)

“For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God;” (Romans 3:23). God's Word reminds us that we have all sinned. The word “sin” means to miss the mark. At one time or another, we have all deliberately chosen to disobey God.

“For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.” (Romans 6:23). A “wage” is a payment. The payment for your sin is death and separation from God in a place that the Bible calls “hell.”

“But God commendeth His love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.” (Romans 5:8). The word “commendeth” means proved. God proved His love for you by giving His own Son, Jesus to die on the cross for your sins.

“That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised Him from the dead, thou shalt be saved.” (Romans 10:9). To believe on Jesus Christ as Savior means to believe that He died for you, paid the price for your sins and that He is the only way to heaven. You can express your belief in Jesus by calling on Him in prayer. . . .

“Dear Jesus, I know that I am a sinner. I believe that You died on the cross and paid the penalty for my sin. I believe that You rose from the dead three days later. I am placing my faith in You alone to forgive my sin and save me. Thank You for giving me eternal life. In Jesus name, AMEN.”
